### 3. Food Services

- Food services are here to hear feedback and suggestions, several changes to the campus food options have been made thanks to issues brought up by students.
- Vegetarian options on campus are good, however pizza was not.
- Students are happy with Gabriels pizza.
- In general, students believe pricing should be lowered slightly, especially the healthier alternatives since they tend to cost more.
- Affordable health alternatives should be available.
- Meal plans are not proportionate to the number of meals a day, this should be revised by the Policy Bylaw committee of the RAUO seeing as Food Services does not have control over meal plan sales.
- While classes start at 830 in the morning, the cafeteria doesn't open until 9am.
- Television screens at the cafeteria entrance are deceiving and it is often difficult to read signs in the cafeteria during rush hour.

- The daily menus are available online, however finding a visible location for menu boards is currently a work in progress.
- Late night study students would like to have access to substantial hot food later at night seeing as Rez Café is the only 24 hour on campus option.
- It is important to keep in mind the demand is quite low for 24 hour food services
- The cafeteria closes at 10, however various stations close at different times.
- If the sandwiches at the Rez Café are of poor quality, consult food services directly.
- Gluten-free should always be available at the pasta bar.
- Please note the patio outside Rez Café is now open.
- All compost goes to the university, most produce is local and sea-food is sustainable
- Chartwells symbol systems describe what is local, sustainable, etc

Future Goals for Food services include:

- A higher capacity seating area
- Serving food in a more efficient manner
- Vegan station, fresh food station, gluten free station
- Food options available in as most buildings as possible
