Stanton

- I sold 80 suckers from the sucker pull and gave away all of the gift cards.
- Housing has re-in forced the walls that were punched in.

Thompson

- My event will be November 25th from noon-4:00pm.
We are going skating (possibly at the rink of dreams) and the 25 first people to get tickets from me will get a free beaver tail.
- I've sold one entire flat and three quarters of another for the sucker pull.

VP Social

- Karaoke event on the 20th of November in the basement of Leblanc from 7:00-9:30pm.
 - ➔ The person from who we are renting the karaoke machine will unload in the back parking lot.
 - ➔ Building representatives please stress that this is a great, modern karaoke machine.
- Hunger Games event on the 21st of November at 8:00pm.
- I received quotes from Jamie (the DJ) for the screens at RezBall – we are still worried that these will take away from people dancing.

VP Marketing and Communications

- Posters need to be stamped.

VP Residents' Affairs

- Food services will not be coming to the town hall because there is nothing to update since the meet and greet (Allan Rock)
 - ➔ Michel says that if there is no town hall he would like to meet with Kaitlynne-Rae and Nardin with Pierre LaRoche as an update
 - ➔ Therefore the town hall is canceled – Kayla please remove this from the website.*
- We received the excel sheets back from Pierre which state the expectations of BeClean (what they do and on which days).
Representatives go see Nardin if you would like them; we are currently looking to get these schedules posted in all residences on every floor after Suzanne translates them.
- An email has been sent to Pierre from Ray regarding Vemma Verve.
- When the shower drains are clogged BeClean is not responsible to snake them out.
When they are clogged fill out a work order form
 - ➔ Encourage residents to clean up after themselves.
- In regards to the smell coming from the products used by BeClean
They were supposed to come on Tuesday to look over the product being used; Pierre will be testing the smell of different products.
 - ➔ They now have to change their water at least three times per floor.
- AEDs – the subsidy came in to buy them on Monday and they should be in within the next two weeks.
- Housing Services is having motion specialists come in to look at options for doors for the shower stalls in Stanton and Marchand.
- 250 rooms still do not have wired internet. The residents are not going to be given compensation because they had access to some Wi-Fi throughout the university grounds; even though this is not the full service promised.
- Murielle would like to put in extra bulletin boards in every residence on every floor – this would cost approximately \$10 000.
- (Question from Mojann) Why are we charged \$15 every time that protection has to open the door for us when we lock ourselves out?
 - ➔ Housing is charged every time that protection has to answer a call (protection is self-financing) as well as this is supposed to be a deterrent for residents to need this service less frequently.
- In regards to the couches broken in Marchand; if a resident can prove that they were not in residence they will not be charged for these damages.
